FAST, FREE COVID-19 TESTING AT ELLIE TOWNE CENTER



The Arizona Department of Health Services has partnered with Arizona State University to launch several testing sites providing free saliva diagnostic testing for COVID-19 in underserved communities around the state. The Ellie Towne Center has been designated as a testing center, providing testing on Wednesdays, Fridays, and Sundays. For those tested at the Ellie Towne Center, test results have been coming back quickly, usually within 24-48 hours. We encourage all Flowing Wells employees to use the Ellie Towne testing center as a resource. All tests must be scheduled online ahead of time - no walk-in appointments will be taken. REQUIRED SUICIDE PREVENTION TRAINING NEXT WEEK

If you work with students Kindergarten through 12th grade, please look for an email link next week for a required suicide prevention training. A new Arizona statute requires the training once every three years. The pandemic has caused an increased number of students who feel isolated, helpless and depressed. This training is a critical step in our continuing efforts to support students in the FW community.

Did you know that you can get copies of your tax return and transcripts online? Are you buying a house or planning to refinance your mortgage? The IRS provides tax transcripts which shows most line items from your tax return as it was originally filed. Are you missing a 1099 from an investment? It will be on the transcript. To access a transcript, go to www.IRS.gov and click on *Order a Transcript*. Create an account by answering a few questions and you will have immediate access to all your tax information for any year that you need it.

MASKS REQUIRED AT ALL FW SITES

The District requires that all Flowing Wells employees, students ages 5 and older, and visitors wear a mask in all Flowing Wells buildings including hallways, public spaces, restrooms, and common areas except where physical distancing of at least six feet is possible. Masks are also required in all Flowing Wells outdoor spaces except where physical distancing of at least 6 feet is possible. Thank you for "masking up!"
