Flu season is here! And for those enrolled in our Blue Cross/Blue Shield medical

plan, make sure you have set up your Teledoc account. It only takes a few minutes to enter in your information. If you haven't used your Teledoc membership yet, here are five good reasons you should:

- 1. Provides 24/7 access to doctors by phone, web, or app.
- 2. You can speak to a licensed doctor about non-emergency health issues from home, work, or on vacation.
- Teledoc doctors can diagnose and treat cold and flu symptoms, allergies, upper respiratory infections, skin problems and more!
- 4. Teledoc doctors can send a prescription to your local pharmacy when medically necessary.
- 5. Your spouse and/or dependents (up to age 26) are eligible for Teledoc even if they are not enrolled in Blue Cross/Blue Shield.
