PFIZER COVID BOOSTER INFORMATION

Any school district employee who received the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine and got the second dose before March 30th is eligible to receive the Pfizer COVID booster shot. Flowing Wells will be holding a Pfizer booster vaccine event next Friday, October 8th in conjunction with the District flu shot clinic. information is available below. Please note:

- The Pima County Health Department and the CDC have clearly stated that it is safe to get your flu shot and your booster shot at or near the same time.
- When anticipating your reaction to the booster shot, you should expect similar side effects to when you received your second dose of the vaccine.
- It is strongly recommended that you do not "mix" vaccines. Therefore, this booster shot is only recommended for those people who originally got the Pfizer vaccine. It is expected that both Moderna and Johnson and Johnson will have booster shot options in the next 2-4 weeks.
- We would love you to come to our district booster event next week! However, if eligible, you can go get your free booster shot anywhere that offers vaccines including your nearest pharmacy. When you go, you will not need to show proof that you work in a school district.

BE AWARE OF FRAUD AND PERSONAL INFORMATION

Fraudulent activity including identity theft continues to be a problem nation-wide. The Flowing Wells Employee Self Service (ESS) online platform houses important personal information for all Flowing Wells employees. The following are a few reminders to keep your personal information secure in Employee Self Service (ESS):

- · Do not share your ESS login information with anyone. If you have already shared your login information with a colleague and would like to have your password reset, please email payroll.account@fwusd.org from your Flowing Wells email account. This will initiate a reset.
- · Review your direct deposit statement to verify the correct bank information is listed.
- If you need to change your direct deposit, complete a Direct Deposit form, available in ESS under Resources. The form must be delivered in person to the payroll department. You may be asked to show ID to verify your identity.
