

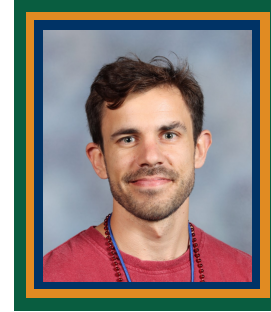

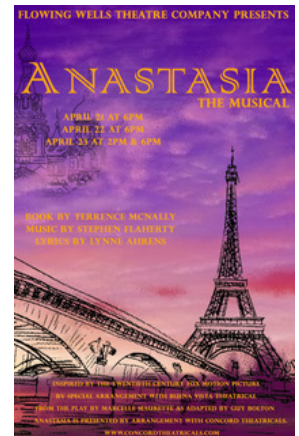
BENEFIT ME OPEN ENROLLMENT EDITION

It's **Open Enrollment** time and we are maintaining all our core benefit offerings with **no increase to your per paycheck deductions!** Now is the time to assess your benefit needs. You can explore your options on our website under Quick Links/Employee Benefits. Attached to this email is an Open Enrollment checklist to help guide your decisions. Since there are no changes to the benefits, **we will again use email to make open enrollment changes.** If you do not want changes to your benefits, please **email Elaine Kimbler** a simple "No changes." You will be re-enrolled in your current selections. If you do want to make changes, email Elaine for the necessary forms.

Open Enrollment will start **May 2nd and end May 13th** with changes taking effect starting July 1, 2022. After the Open Enrollment period closes, you will not be able to make changes unless there is a Qualifying Event. There is one exception to our passive open enrollment. If you are enrolled in the **Flexible Spending Account (FSA), you are required to re-enroll.** You will be sent an email with instructions.

Additionally, we have changed our short-term disability provider to Sun Life. If you are currently enrolled in Guardian, there is nothing more you need to do – you will automatically be switched to Sun Life. If you have a current claim with Guardian, they will continue to administer your claim for the duration. Speaking of short-term disability, you might consider signing up for the voluntary buy-up! Sun Life is providing us with great rates and it is extra income protection if you experience a non-work related illness or injury that prevents you from working for a length of time. You can receive up to 66-2/3rds of your salary to help pay for essential expenses, including food, utilities, mortgage and car payments. And for this year only, you can sign up without completing a medical evidence of insurability. Please review the information on our website and email Elaine if you want to enroll.
