NEW PROCEDURE FOR OUTGOING CALLS

Beginning October 24, all outgoing calls from every District phone will require the use of the 520 area code. To place an outgoing call on a District phone, you will need to dial 9, then the area code, then the seven-digit number (for example: 9 - 520 - XXX - XXXX). By the way, this change is not specific to Flowing Wells it applies to your personal phone lines as well. It is important to note that in an emergency, students, teachers and staff will be able to dial 911 as normal to reach emergency services.

FREE RAPID TESTS FOR FW STAFF

Every Flowing Wells school site now has the ability to offer free Abbott Binax rapid COVID-19 testing to staff members. The test is easy and non-invasive. Test results only take 15 minutes. If you have been exposed to a confirmed case of COVID-19, or if you have COVID-like symptoms and want some peace of mind, please talk to your principal or health office assistant for more information. Flowing Wells staff members can also contact Dr. Parkinson via phone or email to schedule a rapid test. As a reminder, if you have Covid-like symptoms, even if you are vaccinated, please stay home and get tested.
