Please assist us in helping your child demonstrate they are ready to be promoted to the next grade by encouraging focus and dedication to schoolwork. Let's finish the year strong. As they say at the U of A, it is time to "Bear Down"!

April 3rd – 4th, 15th- 19th - AASA Testing! We will be giving students in grades 3-6 their AASA state assessment. AASA assessments are in reading, writing, and math. *Testing starts at 8:00 a.m.* **Parents**, please help your student to be at school each day, on time. We also would appreciate your help in scheduling appointments for afternoons or on days testing is not occurring. If your child is absent anytime during testing, we will need to test them the following week. Please have your child get plenty of rest, eat a healthy breakfast, and encourage a "can do" attitude. All K- 6 students who are here on time each day during testing days will participate in an attendance challenge with the chance to earn attendance incentives! Thank you for supporting this important event as these state assessments are an essential component of your child's overall performance record.

April 3rd- Our monthly **PTO** meeting will be held from 2:30-3:30 in our Media Center. Spanish translation and childcare will be available. We would LOVE to have you there!

Long Weekend Break – No School! There will be no school Friday, March 29th and Monday, April 1st. School will resume on Tuesday, April 2nd.

- A new State Law requires that all students must have one Tdap and one Meningococcal vaccine **by their 11th birthday.**

PLAN AHEAD. Vaccines are available through your child's pediatrician or Pima County Health Department Clinics.

April is a busy month for first grade! We will be having a first-grade performance on **April 11th** at 5:30 pm. We will be celebrating Earth Day a little early and singing about why we love our Earth. The evening performance will begin at 5:30. Be on the lookout for a note explaining when the students need to arrive and what to wear.

First grade will also be taking a field trip to the OdySEA Aquarium, in Scottsdale, AZ, on **April 23rd**. Since this is a big field trip, students **MUST** have good behavior and complete all assignments to attend. Please be on the lookout for a permission slip that will be sent home soon. Teachers have **ALREADY** contacted chaperones for this field trip.

The countdown has begun for the final Acadience reading test of the year. Please be sure your child is reading for at least **20 minutes each day**, including weekends. The more they read, the better they will become at reading. Also, remember to have your child retell details and major events from the story after they read. In addition, we getting ready to take our end of the year math test, which covers everything they have learned this year. At home you can help them prepare by telling time to the hour and half hour, skip count by 2s, 5s, and 10s, count & write numbers from 0 – 120, and practice their addition and subtraction.

At this point in the year, our classrooms are running low on supplies. We would greatly appreciate any donations of snacks, Kleenex and hand sanitizer. Teachers may also be reaching out with a few items that are needed and we start our end of the year countdown for May. 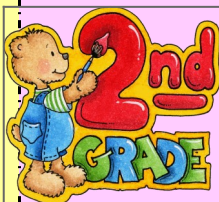
