Hello Bulldog families!

For the second quarter our students are trying to get eight days without a negative referral. So far, they have earned six of the eight days. Please continue asking your child how they demonstrate P.A.W.S. every day at school and share that you want to see pictures of Mr. Blanco taped to the wall.

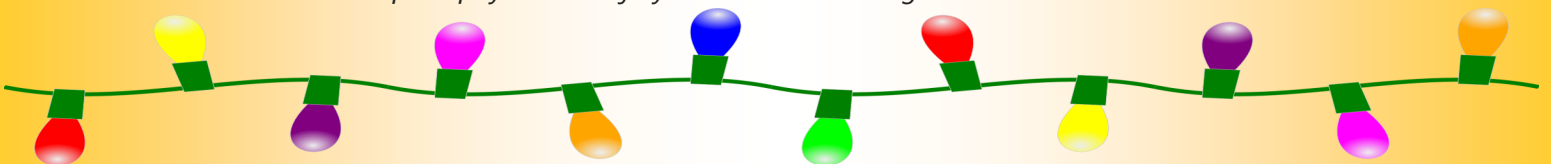

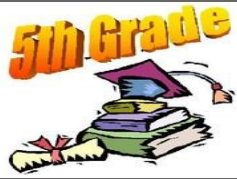
