Dear Parents,

Love is in the air....love of reading that is! February is designated as “Love of Reading” month here at Douglas. During the week of February 12th through the 16th we will have many activities celebrating reading including guest readers. Please take some time this month to sit down with your child and read a story together, share with them why you enjoy reading, and encourage them to enrich their lives by reading as much as they possibly can.

In addition to Love of Reading activities, we have many other events during the month of February and we hope to see you at any one or all of them.

- ◆ **February 6th – 6th grade parent information night at Flowing Wells Junior High.** This event runs from 6-7 p.m.
- ◆ **February 7th - Title I Spring Review Meeting**, at 2:15 in the Downstairs Media Center. Prior to the PTO meeting, we will be sharing Title One Parent Survey data and asking parents for feedback in preparation for the 2024-2025 school year. We would love to have you there! PTO meeting immediately to follow at 2:30.
- ◆ **February 8th - Half Day.** Students will be dismissed at noon, please make arrangements for your child’s after school care. There will be no after school SKILLS for Success Program that day.
- ◆ **February 14th-** Grade levels will plan age appropriate Valentine’s Day celebrations where students will be able to exchange cards and treats. Please remember that if you chose to bring in treats for your child’s classroom, they must be store bought and in the original package.
- ◆ **February 12th- 16th - Book Fair.** Students and families will be able to purchase books. We will be open every morning from 7:30-7:55 a.m. We will also be open for Family Night on Tuesday, February 13th from 5-7 p.m. As a special part for Love of Reading week, our Title One Reading Lab will hold a Family Night event during the Book Fair Family Night. Students are invited to the Reading Lab between 5:00-6:00. They can bring books they have purchased, or the Title One staff will have books on hand. S’mores will be served and families are encouraged to sit down and read a book with their child. Hope to see you there!
- ◆ **February 15th-** This is a big night with two events! Our 2nd graders will be putting on their spring “Weather” performance at 5:30 in the MPR. This is going to be a **great** show! Also on the 15th Tucson Village Farms will be hosting a Flowing Wells Night from 4:00-7:00. They will be providing a free, farm fresh dinner and there will be lots of activities to take part in. WOW, It's February! Where did January go? Our Bulldogs are doing wonderful things at Douglas. We are so proud of their hard work and dedication to being the best students in Flowing Wells. Our students have earned 8 days without any negative referrals since we returned from winter break, our goal is to reach 10 days. If we reach our goal of ten, then we have a Switch-a-Roo Surprise for the third quarter incentive. Please remind your child(ren) to continue to follow P.A.W.S. everywhere they go on campus and to always do their personal best.

I would like to take this opportunity to remind our Bulldog families about the Flowing Wells School District attendance policy, which states that the total number of excused, unexcused, and pre-arranged absences shall be limited to 10 per school year for elementary school students. Any absences in excess of the 10 must be verified by a certified health professional. Let's work together to make sure we have your student(s) on time for school every day, and prepared to learn.

I would also like to remind parents that during morning drop-off, only those who are parking and walking their students on to campus may come through the front parking lot. If you would like to drop off your student, please use the back alley. We are having some issues with students being picked up after school in the parking lot. Any parent that would like to pick up their child must park and meet them under the Ramada. Our priority is to keep a safe campus and we need everyone's help to accomplish this goal. Thank you for all your support.

February is a busy month for us! First grade will celebrate Valentine's Day on Wednesday, February 14th. A note was sent home including information about Valentines and our in-class celebration. Please keep an eye on your Remind for additional information. First grade will also be taking a field trip to the Reid Park Zoo on February 20th. Permission slips were already sent home. We highly encourage families to practice addition and subtraction math facts at home. This can be done through flash cards or counting groups of items and adding them together or taking some away. *It would also benefit your child to practice time to the hour and half hour.* Don't forget the homework reading log goal for reading each day is **20 minutes!** If your child finishes a book and still has time left, have them start another story. Please monitor that your child is reading the full 20 minutes each night. As you listen to your child read, be sure to ask questions about the story to help practice their comprehension skills. It is helpful to remind them to answer questions in complete and detailed sentences rather than short responses. Book Fair and Love of Reading week are this month, so it is a great time to get your child excited to read. We LOVE our students and families and greatly appreciate your continued support this year!



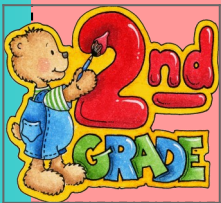

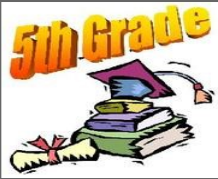

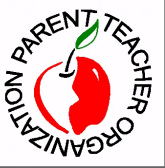
