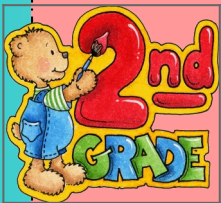

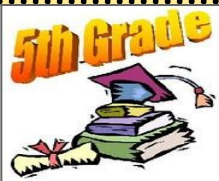
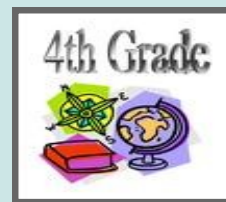

- \*Variety Show People make sure you are practicing your acts! The second audition is coming up soon.

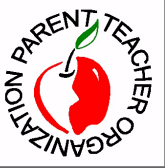
