Student Late Sign-In and Early Sign-Out

If a student is **late to class** (after 8 am bell rings), he/she **must** check in at the front office to receive a late pass, otherwise your child **will** be marked absent. A parent or responsible adult must sign him/her in at the front office and receive a late pass.

Signing-Out- Please Note: Students signed out before dismissal, will be marked PM Late. Minutes lost in the afternoon are the same as minutes lost in the morning. Also, please remember, we will not call students out of their classroom until a parent or responsible adult is at the front office. Unfortunately, we've had situations in the past where students were left waiting, resulting in the loss of valuable learning time. All students need to be signed out using the laptop provided in the front office.

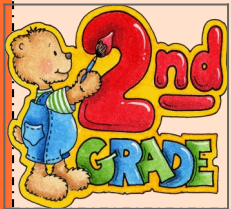

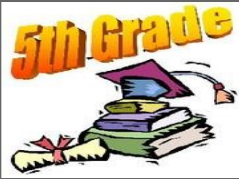

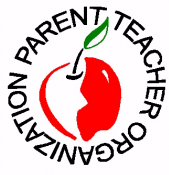
